Tirreno boasts excellent flavor and fruit quality.

A main season variety that produces high yields of 2-3 lb. fruits, Tirreno is rapidly becoming a standard in Northern regions.

This variety has dark green sutures that turn yellow at the edges to indicate harvest maturity. The sweet, crisp flesh is a rich orange color. Reliable sugars and outstanding, aromatic flavor make this variety a favorite among all types of growers. Tirreno has good shelf life thanks to its slightly thicker rind and firm flesh.

Tirreno has a vigorous plant habit and resistance to Fusarium wilt (Fom:0-2), as well as Melon necrotic spot virus (MNSV). It also has tolerance against Powdery mildew (PX) making it an excellent choice for organic growers.
